






Artist Loft 6:00PM VOCAL JAZZ WORKSHOP


Artist Loft 6:00PM IN CONVERSATION


Factory Theatre 7:00PM IFE OGUNJOBI



Ife Ogunjobi is a London raised musician born to parents whose music Nigerian an amalgamation of the sounds around his upbringing. Growing up in South East London, his surroundings have enriched his music with various genres such as Jazz, Afrobeat and Hiphop. Influenced by the likes of Fela Kuti, Erykah Badu and Roy Hargrove, his musical concept removes the barriers between the different genres of music and portrays his authentic sound.



Spielman Theatre 8:30PM EMMA RAWICZ



Emma Rawicz is a multi-award winning young saxophonist and composer, making waves on the UK music scene and beyond. She has been described as "An astonishing new talent" (Jamie Cullum – BBC Radio 2), 'a force to be reckoned with' (Jazzwise) and 'a fast-rising star' (London Jazz News). Her music has a unique sound, fusing all her many influences, and her compositions range from lilting Afro Cuban inspired grooves to hard hitting modern jazz and funk numbers.



Factory Theatre 9:30 PM ELECTRIC LADY BIG BAND



Jimi Hendrix's revolutionary mix of rock, blues, jazz, funk, soul and psychedelia remains as potent today as it was in the late 60's when he exploded onto the scene. Electric Lady Big Band attempt to expand that soundscape for large ensemble; all with love and respect for Jimi's genius. "A unique and heartfelt testimony to the music and legacy of Jimi Hendrix."

Spielman Theatre 12:00PM ALICE ZAWADZKI



Described by MOJO magazine as "something of a phenomenon... as maverick as Fever Ray or Joanna Newsome", Alice's musical style has always been hard to categorise, but at its core lies a devotion to the art of storytelling, warmly embracing the audience, and luminosity of sound. An early immersion in New Orleans jazz and gospel, her classical training as a violinist, and her constant exploration of improvised and roots music, inform a unique style and heartfelt performances.



Factory Theatre 1:00PM ADRIAN COX



Internationally acclaimed jazz clarinettist Adrian Cox at age 40 is certainly performing at the top of his game. He is one of the leading exponents of New Orleans clarinet and has a huge wealth of knowledge for the music and the players of the era. Todays concert will demonstrate that connection with the great city of New Orleans paying homage to his clarinet playing idols, Barney Bigard, Sidney Bechet, Ed Hall and more.




Spielman Theatre 2:30PM THE JAZZ DEFENDERS



Led by one of the UK's most formidable jazz pianists, George Cooper, The Jazz Defenders are a group born from a deep love of Blue Note jazz, drawing on a wealth of inspiration to craft their own raw and vibrant compositions. Having played several shows at Ronnie Scott's Jazz Club as well as many other prestigious venues in the UK, they continue to electrify audiences with their energy and virtuosity.



Factory Theatre 4:00PM ELLES BAILEY



Elles Bailey, the smokey voiced, human dynamo who has powered her way to the forefront of the British blues and roots scene in recent years, unveiled her eagerly-awaited third album 'Shining in the Half Light' in the spring of 2022. Crammed with vibrant originals brought to life with her Alist band, it's another significant step forward in a career already feted with awards & acclaim generated by her two previous studio sets Wildfire and Road I Call Home.



Spielman Theatre 5:30PM SUNTOU SUSSO



Suntou is a multi-instrumentalist: Kora player, percussionist, singer and composer from The Gambia. Born a Griot in a 700-year old tradition, the Kora - harp-lute with 22 strings - is unique to the Griots of the Mandinka people. Griots have a unique societal role as oral historians, transmitting and preserving a people's culture through the generations in song, music and poetry.



Factory Theatre 7:00PM CLARE TEAL QUINTET



She's back! Expect exhilarating swing from award winning jazz vocalist and long time Radio 2 & Jazz FM broadcaster Clare Teal and her marvellous band who return with a fabulous new show as ever celebrating the hits and hidden gems of the Great American and British Songbooks, plus contemporary covers and originals. The concert will also include favourites from her acclaimed DVD The Fireside Sessions.



Factory Theatre 8:00PM HIPPO



Hippo thrives in the hinterland between jazz and electronica. Bursting with buoyant melodies and the adrenal energy of a band stretching their shows to the edge of possibility, the trio continues to make a colossal sound far beyond what their three-piece stature should permit.

Saxophones, synthesisers and drums go in, Hippo comes out.



Factory Theatre 9:30PM SNAZZBACK



Snazzback bring a renewed, daring energy to UK dance music. The 7-piece embrace their experimental beginnings to create a sound fusing abstract beats with spiralling improvisation. Their music is soaked in influences including interlocking West African rhythms, rootsy Brazilian flavours, sprawling soundscapes, deep dubstep basslines and flickering arpeggiators. A collaborative instinct runs through the group, and an eclectic choice of vocalists keeps their compositions shimmering with new possibility.



Factory Theatre 1:00PM VIMALA ROWE &



JOHN ETHERIDGE

Legendary guitarist John Etheridge joins forces with the sensational vocals of Vimala Rowe. Together, they weave a magical spell, effortlessly travelling musically from India to Africa, Middle East and the USA. Their album 'Out of the Sky' was elected in the Top Ten critic's choice of album of the year 2016 in both the Guardian and the Sunday Times the track 'Detour Ahead 'in the Top Five in the Guardian.



Factory Theatre 4:00PM ANDY SHEPPARD



Andy Sheppard Trio marks an unprecedented encounter between the masterful saxophonist Andy Sheppard, the Italian jazz icon pianist Rita Marcotulli and one of the most prominent bassists in the European circuit, the French bassist Michel Benita. Three highly individual musicians, all of which had a big role in shaping what we call the sound of European jazz today.



Factory Theatre 6:30PM DENNIS ROLLINS



For 25 years trombonist Dennis Rollins has played at the forefront of the UK jazz, funk and pop as an 'impossibly virtuosic' sideman to such stars such as Maceo Parker, Pee Wee Ellis, Courtney Pine, The Brand New Heavies, Blur, Monty Alexander and as an award-winning leader in his own right. Featuring Hammond organ virtuoso Ross Stanley and fiery drummer Joel Barford. It's clear that this is one of Rollins' strongest musical statements yet.



Factory Theatre 9:00PM RENEGADE BRASS BAND



Renegade Brass Band, hailing from the northern English city of Sheffield, combine 8 horns, 2 percussionists, a scratch DJ and live MC, to form a raw brass mixture of Jazz, Hip-Hop and Funk in their unstoppable, high-energy live shows. Having played packed out gigs at venues around the UK, Renegade Brass Band have established themselves as the country's premiere hip-hop brass band outfit.




